Oregon voters passed Oregon's Medical Marijuana Act in 1998 to allow people with debilitating conditions to use marijuana for medicinal purposes. The Act provides for a narrow exception to the criminal laws; however a lack of program oversight, high possession limits, anonymity and ambiguity in the law has created an environment where abuse is widespread. As of January 2010, there are more than 26,000 patients, 15,000 grow sites and 13,000 caregivers. Each patient can possess 6 mature plants, 18 seedlings and 24 ounces of marijuana. Over 3,700 grow sites had multiple persons growing for multiple patients. Join us March 12th to discuss the need for program oversight and controls to restrict the significant abuse of the law, the illicit market and the victimization of legitimate patients.

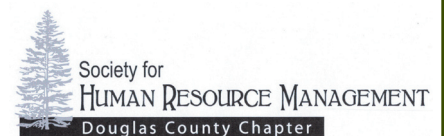
